Sabala Yojana

By centralizing the integrated development and empowerment of adolescent girls in the age of 11-18 years, Child Development projects have been initiated under Government of India aided Sabala Yojana in Haridwar, Chamoli, Uttarkashi and Nainital districts. Rs.3.80 lac per year per project is proposed to be spent for this. 2.08 lac adolescent girls have been identified during the survey in selected districts. In Anganwadi centres, one Sakhi and two Sahelis will be selected and the group of these adolescent girls will be given training and activities like distribution of IFA, gaining knowledge through 'Kishori Kit' and celebration of 'Kishori Day' will be organised. Provision has been made in Sabala Yojana to provide supplementary nutrition feeding to the girls in age of 11 to 14 years not going to school and all adolescent girls in the age of 15 to 18 years. A committee has been constituted under the Chairmanship of District Magistrate at district level for implementation, monitoring and evaluation of the scheme.
